- Elementary grades K-5
 - 23 to 25 per class
 - Music, PE, library/media resource, technology lab and special education
- Middle Schools grades 6-8
 - ▶ 25 students per classroom with 20 to 70 students in special program spaces
 - English, math, social studies, science, physical education, music, art and electives
- High Schools grades 9-12
 - ▶ 25 students per classroom with 20 to 70 students in special program spaces
 - English, history, science, math, physical education, music, art and electives

 - New Elementary School #22: \$37,280,736
 - Heritage High School Addition: \$26,939,489
 - ► Land for New Middle School and potential future Elementary School: \$12,000,000
 - Expansion of Transportation: \$10,000,000
 - Remaining bond funded projects: \$774,829,775
