- WHEREAS, the City of Camas actively supports the goals of equality, opportunity, full participation, independent living, and economic self-sufficiency for all people with disabilities; and
- WHEREAS, we all have a role to play in increasing opportunities for meaningful employment for people with disabilities and by joint resolution the United States Congress has designated October as National Disability Employment Awareness Month; and
- WHEREAS, the theme of this year's Awareness Month is "#inclusionworks" in order to raise awareness of disability employment issues and honors the contributions of America's workers with disabilities;
- THEREFORE, I, Scott Higgins, Mayor of the City of Camas, do hereby proclaim October, 2016, as:
