Chair Niles adjourned the meeting at 5:20 p.m.

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







PURPOSE: Pat Guard, owner of Columbia Litho at 302 NE 6th Avenue has requested that two parking spots on the south side of NE 6th Avenue adjacent to his business be changed to a 30-Minute Parking time limit. Pat states,

"I am writing in hopes you can help us at Columbia Litho get a change to the parking area in front of our building at 302 NE 6th Ave.

With all of the ongoing changes I know are being made and the large complex across 6th Ave, from us I foresee a need to secure better parking access for our clients to utilize on a short term parking basis.

I'd like to see the south side of 6th Ave. in front of our offices have a couple of dedicated parking spots of 30 minute (or whatever they qualify for) spots for client use."
