f) Liability Insurance

Contractor shall maintain Commercial General Liability Insurance coverage for the entire period they are working on this project. This insurance coverage shall be for the types of insurance listed and for the minimum amounts specified in the Small Works Contract.

The Contractor shall provide the City with a certificate documenting that coverage. Said certificate must be provided on a standard "ACORD" form, or its equivalent, and must provide that coverage shall not be canceled or modified without 30 days prior written notice to the City of Vancouver. 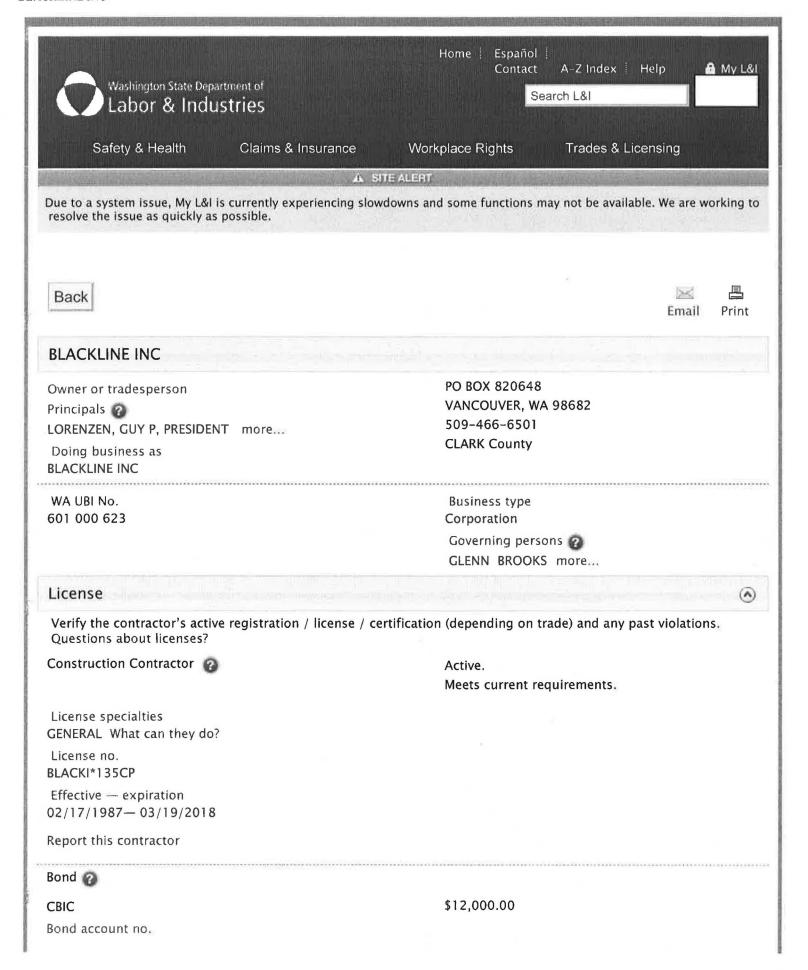
