Phil Bourquin introduced a revised draft of the Wireless Communications CMC amendments as Exhibit 16 and responded to the Commissioners' queries. He relayed staff's recommendation to open the public testimony portion of the hearing to allow those present an opportunity to speak.

Chair Beel opened the public testimony portion of the hearing.

Staff responded to the concerns expressed.

The public testimony portion of the hearing was closed.

After a lengthy discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Hull, seconded by Commissioner Goodlett to forward a recommendation to City Council to approve the proposed amendments to Camas Municipal Code 18.35 with Planning Commission's revisions noted on pages 3, 4, 5, 9 and 10. Adding that City Council consider revising the approval process for Type III wireless communication facilities applications to include a public hearing

before Planning Commission instead of the Hearings Examiner. The motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

Phil Bourquin stated that this item will be scheduled for a public hearing before City Council on June 19, 2017.

A brief recess began at 7:15 p.m., for an estimated 10 minutes. The meeting reconvened at 8:26 p.m.

B. Presentation of Proposed Minor Amendments to Camas Municipal Code (CMC) Title 18 Zoning

Details: As part of a periodic code update, the proposed minor amendments to Title 18 Zoning of the Camas Municipal Code (CMC) include updates to clarify sections that may have been challenging to administer since the last review update, new additions and corrections including typos. Staff provided a staff report to summarize the proposed amendments including two attachments. Attachment 1 is the redlined version that illustrates the proposed changes and Attachment 2 is a version of the proposed amendments without red-lines. The current CMC is available online at the city's web site.
