

### Question 1

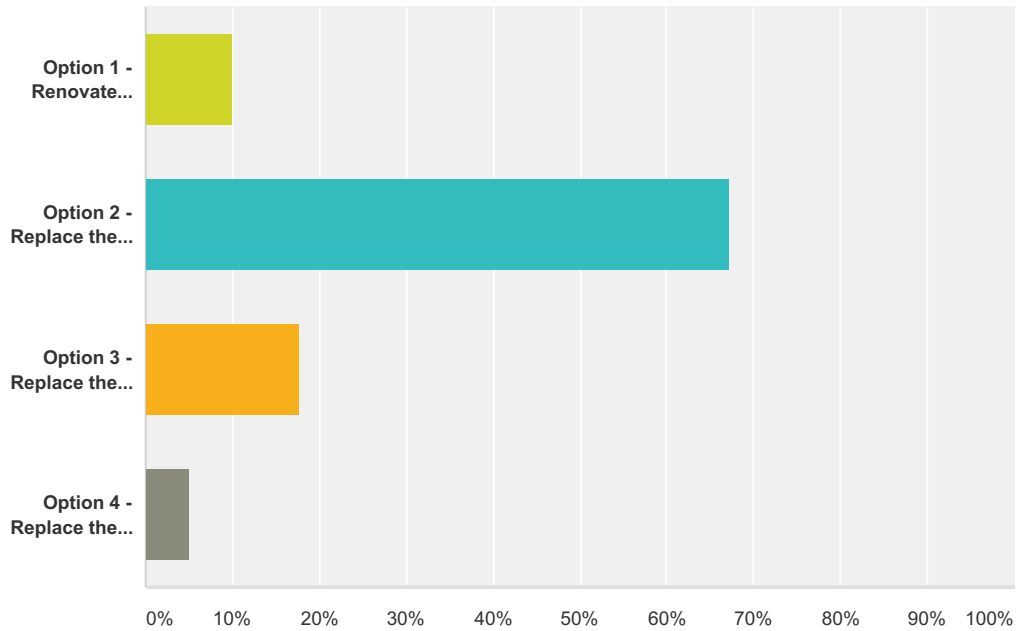

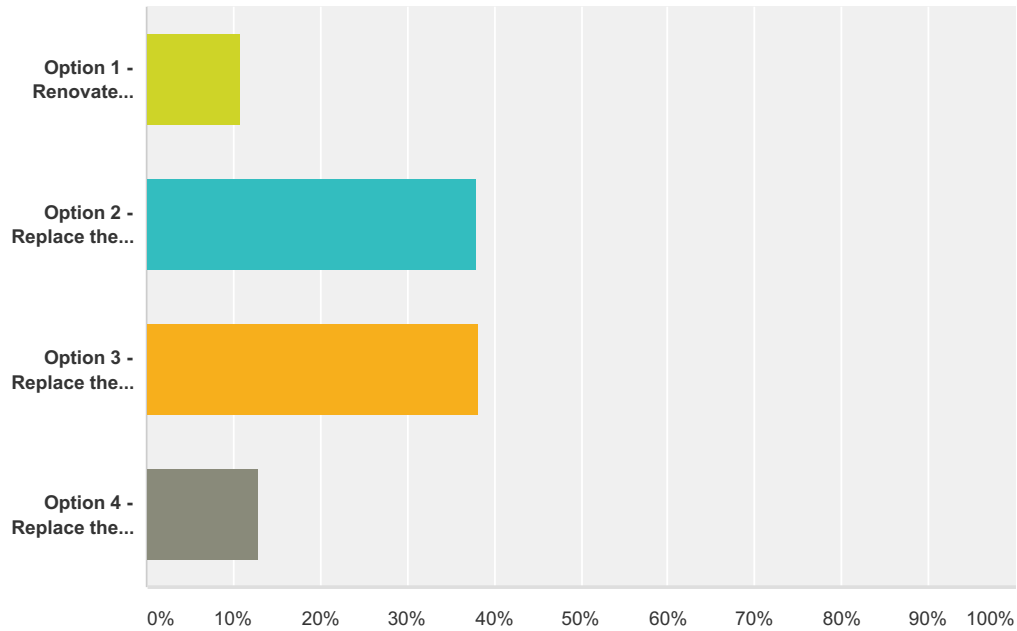

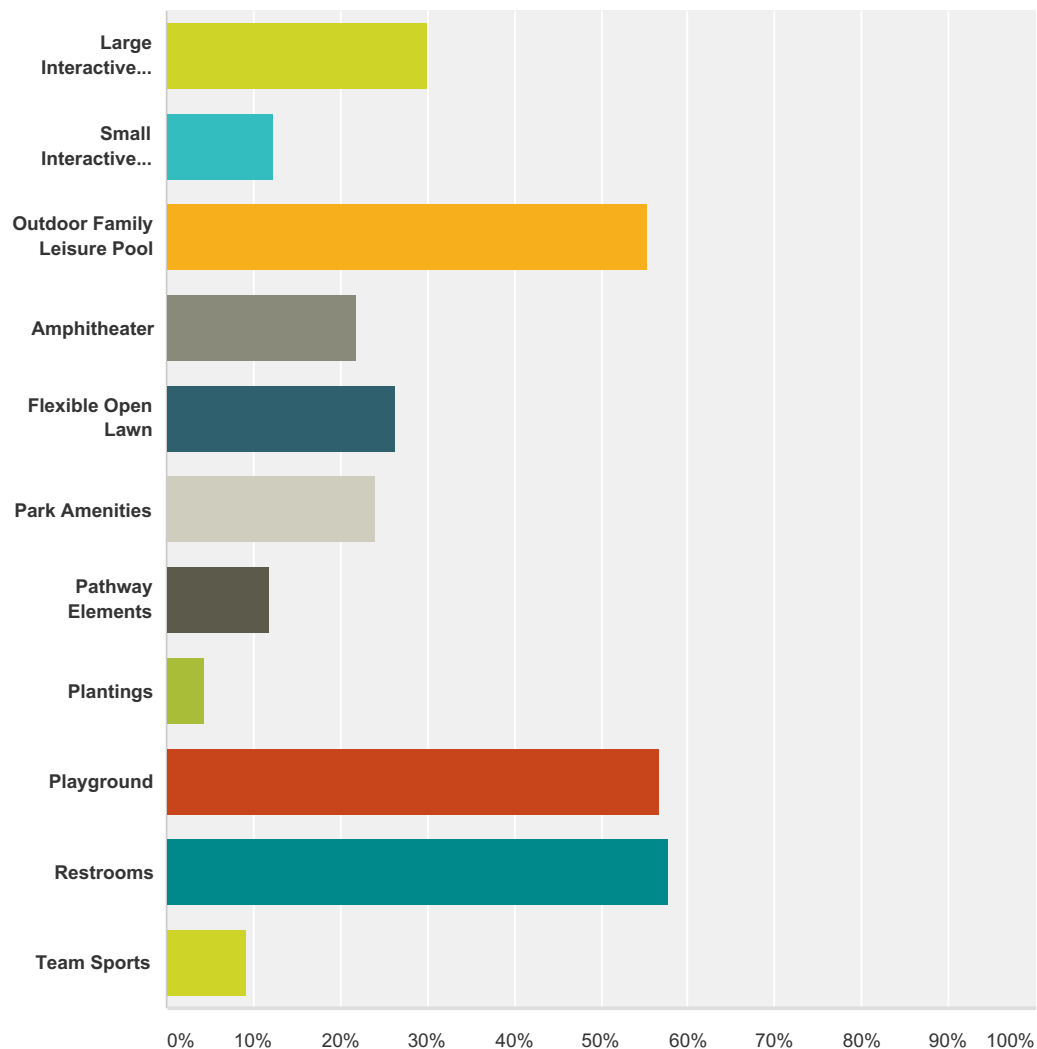

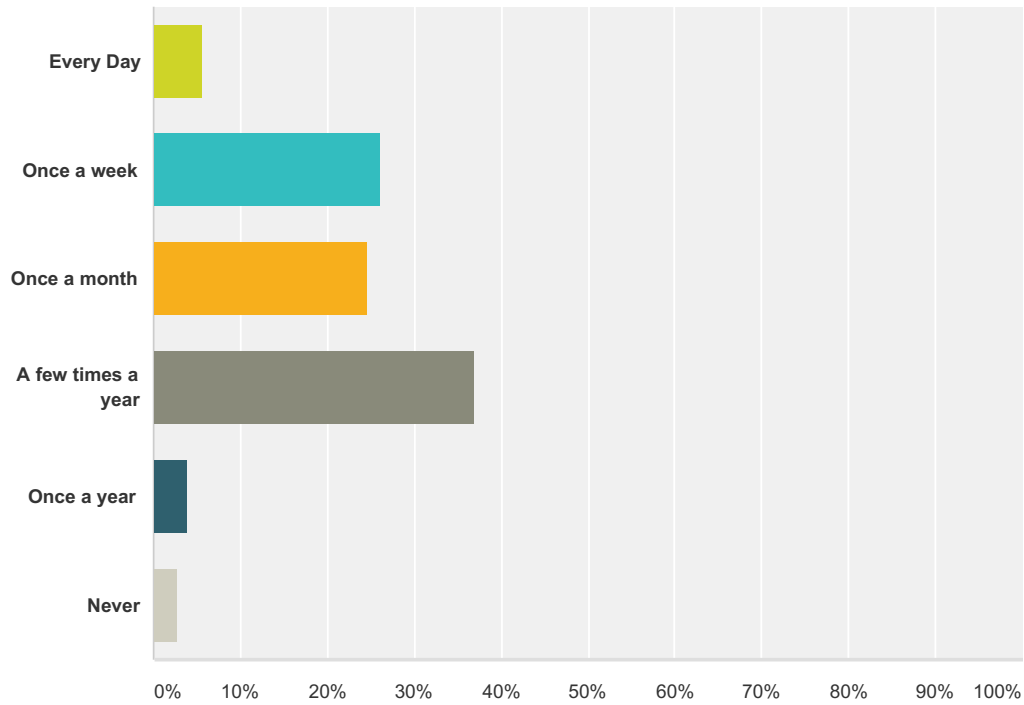

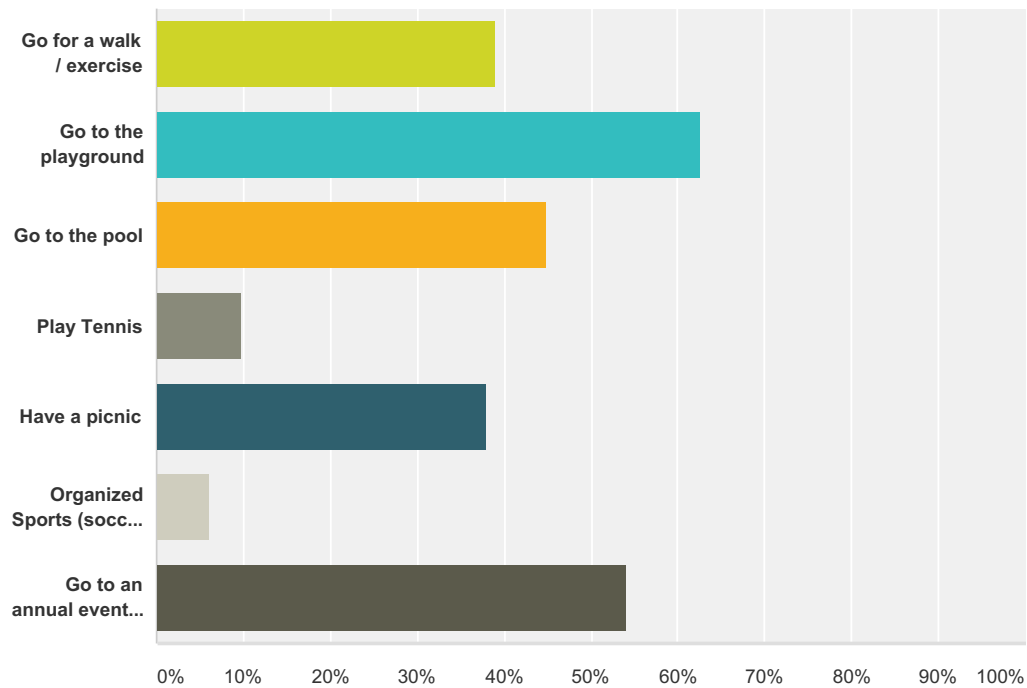

## Q5 What do you do when you visit Crown Park?

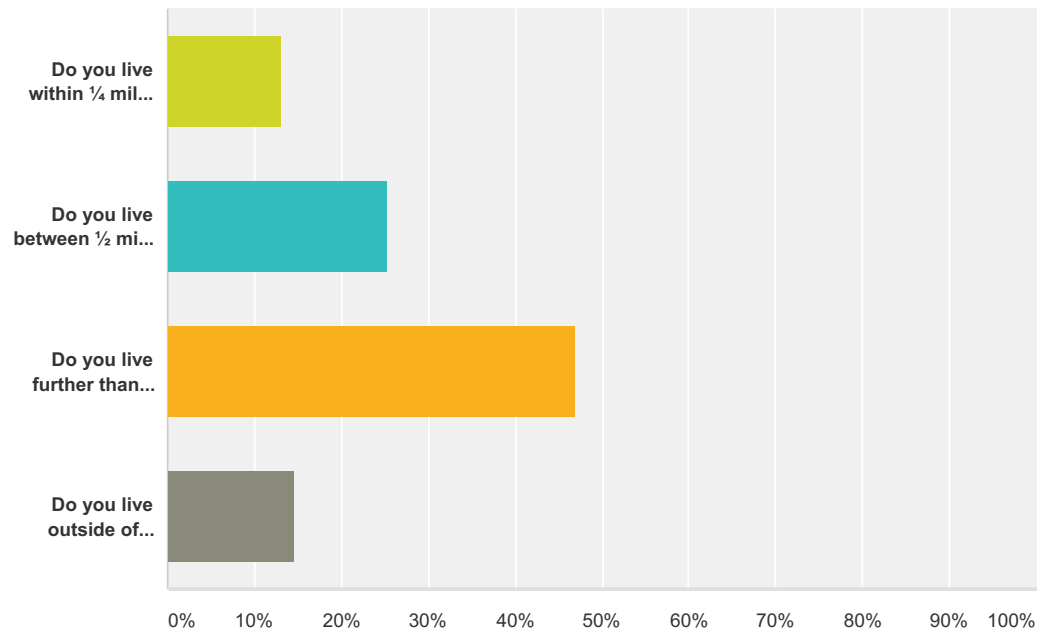
