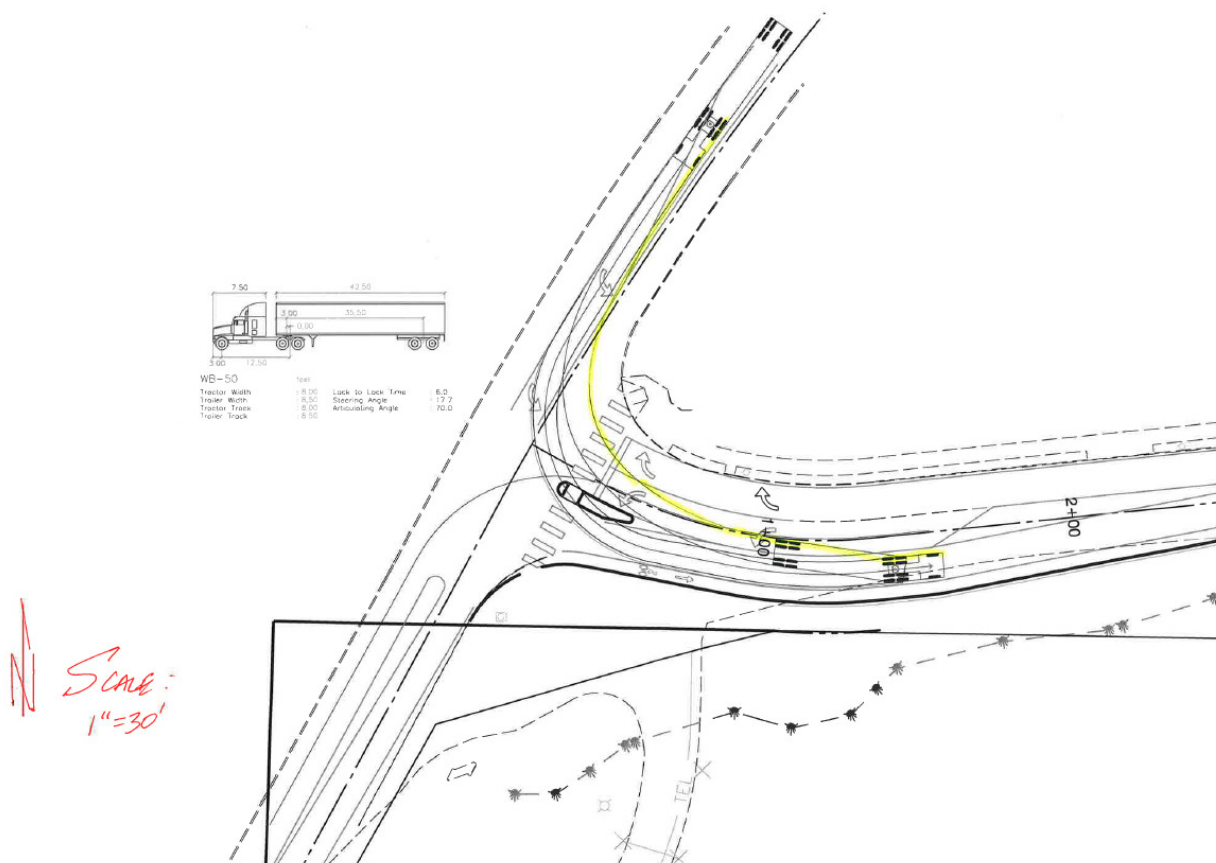

Please note that this island will obviously have a significant impact on left turn movements for large vehicles. We ran turn movements for a WB50 truck and 45' bus and neither was close to being able to make it with the island, particularly the left turn from Brady onto McIntosh.

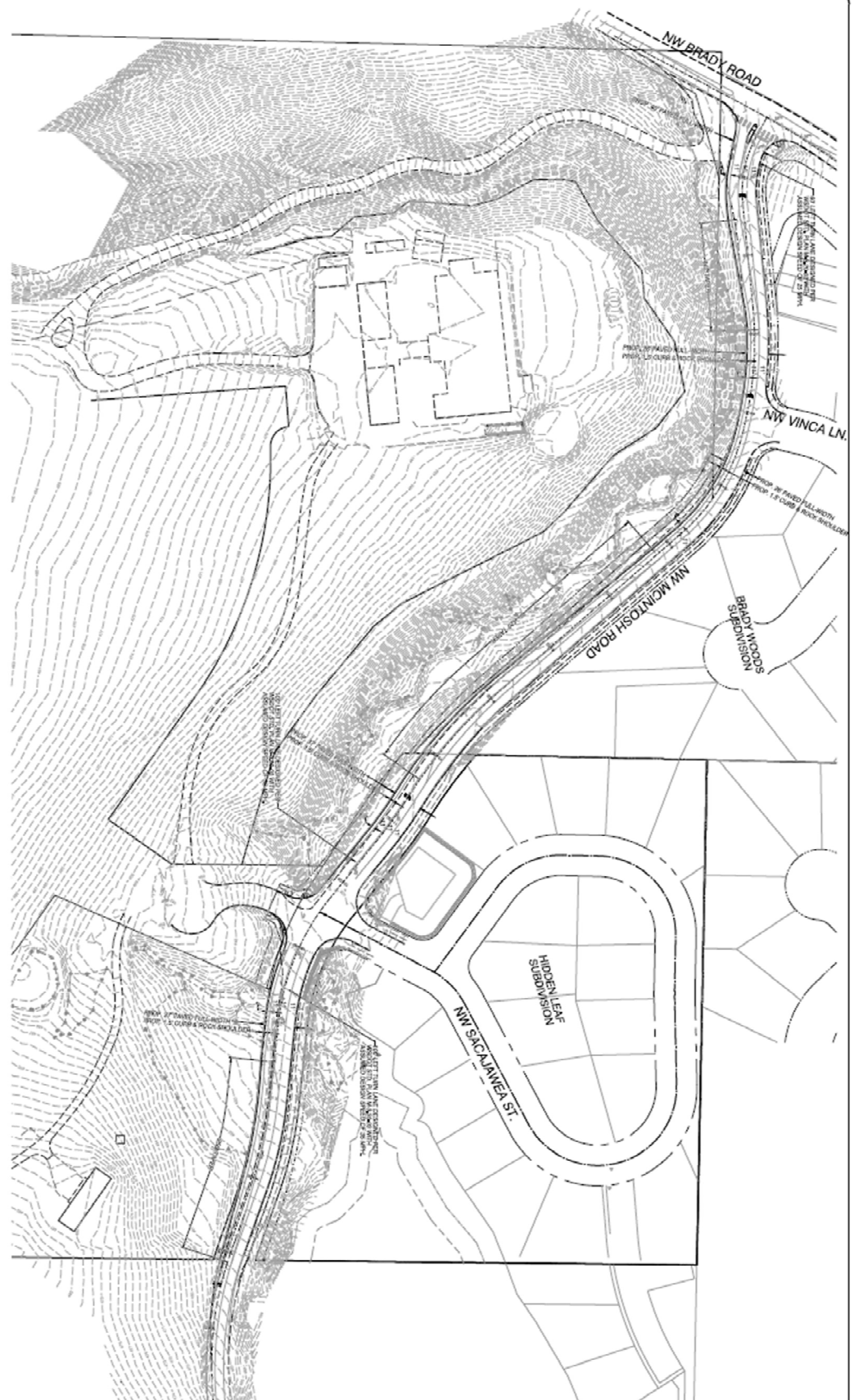
