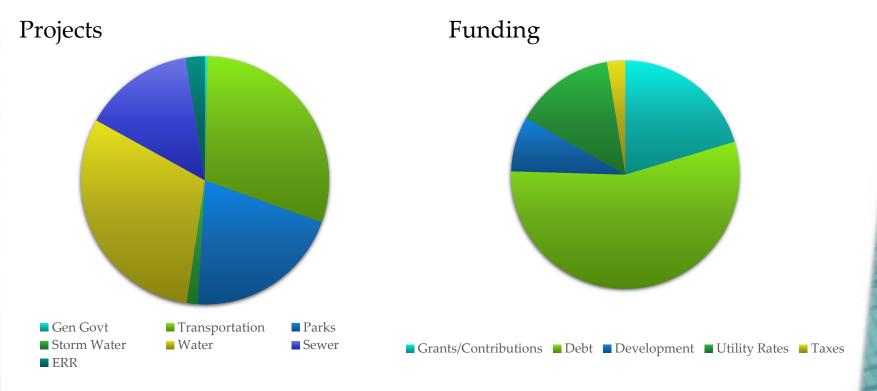

- 69 Projects at \$66.9 million for 2019-2020

• 4 project in General Government	\$640,000
• 9 projects in Transportation	\$20.9 million
• 19 projects in Parks	\$13.6 million
• 8 projects in Storm Water	\$924,000
• 12 projects in Water	\$19.5 million
• 8 projects in Sewer	\$9.2 million
• 9 project in ERR	\$2.2 million
