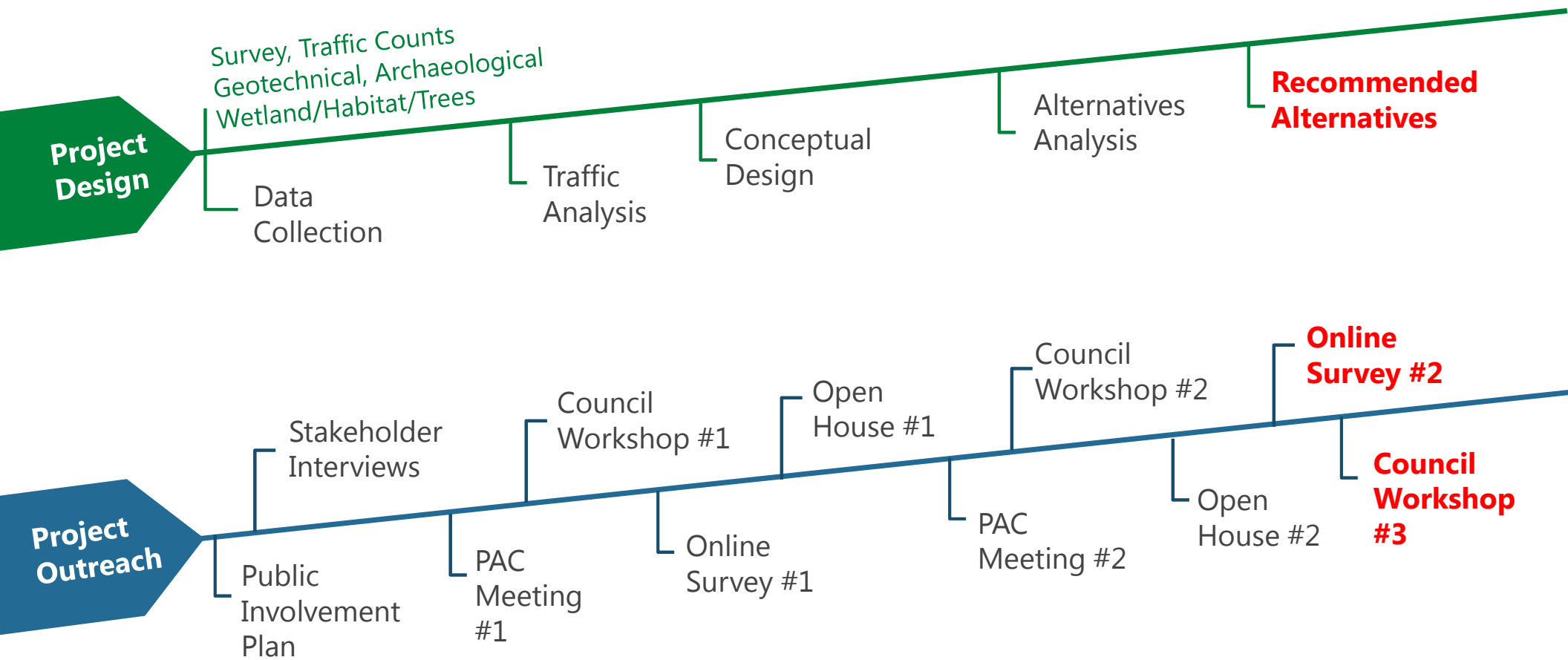

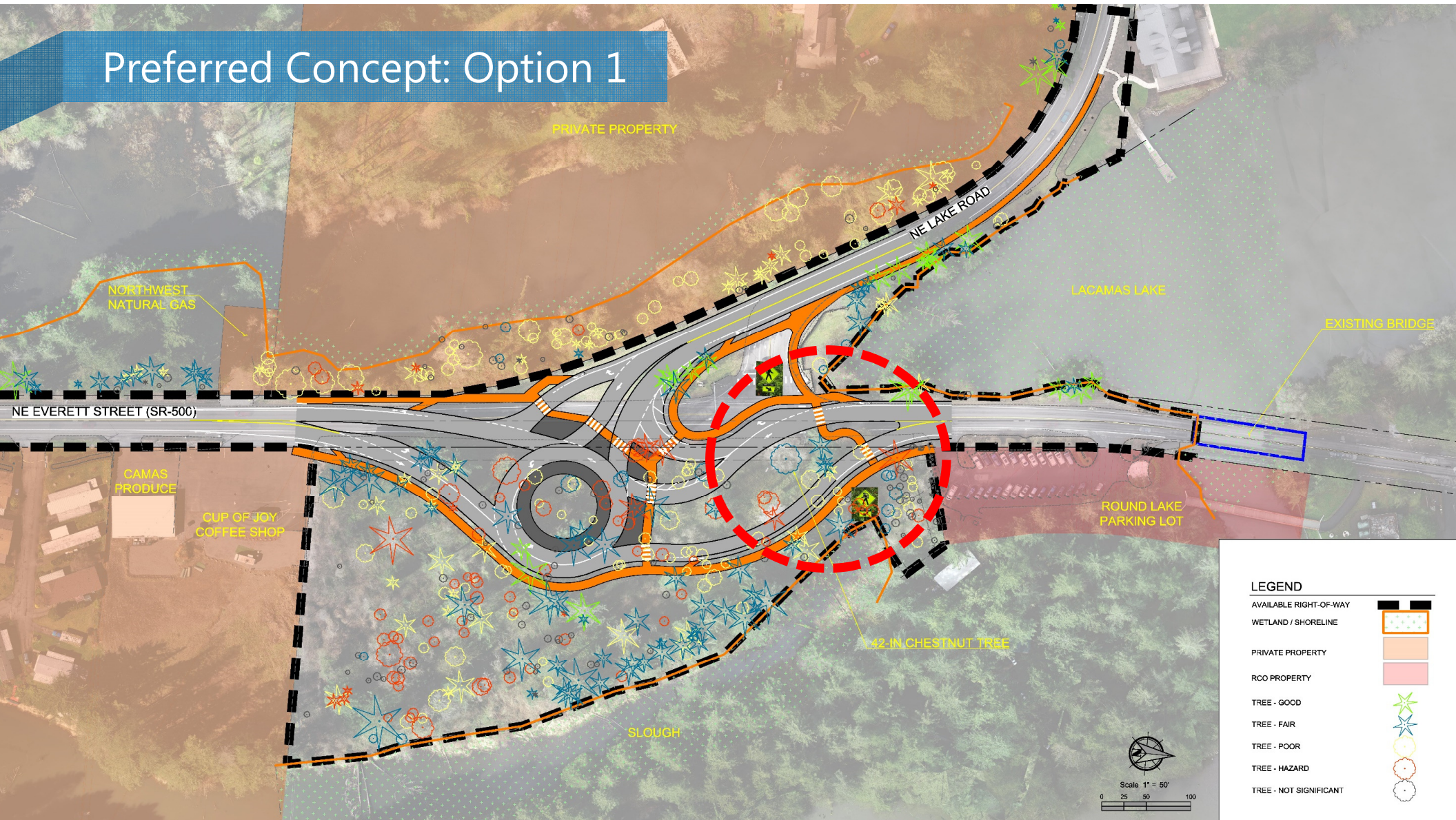

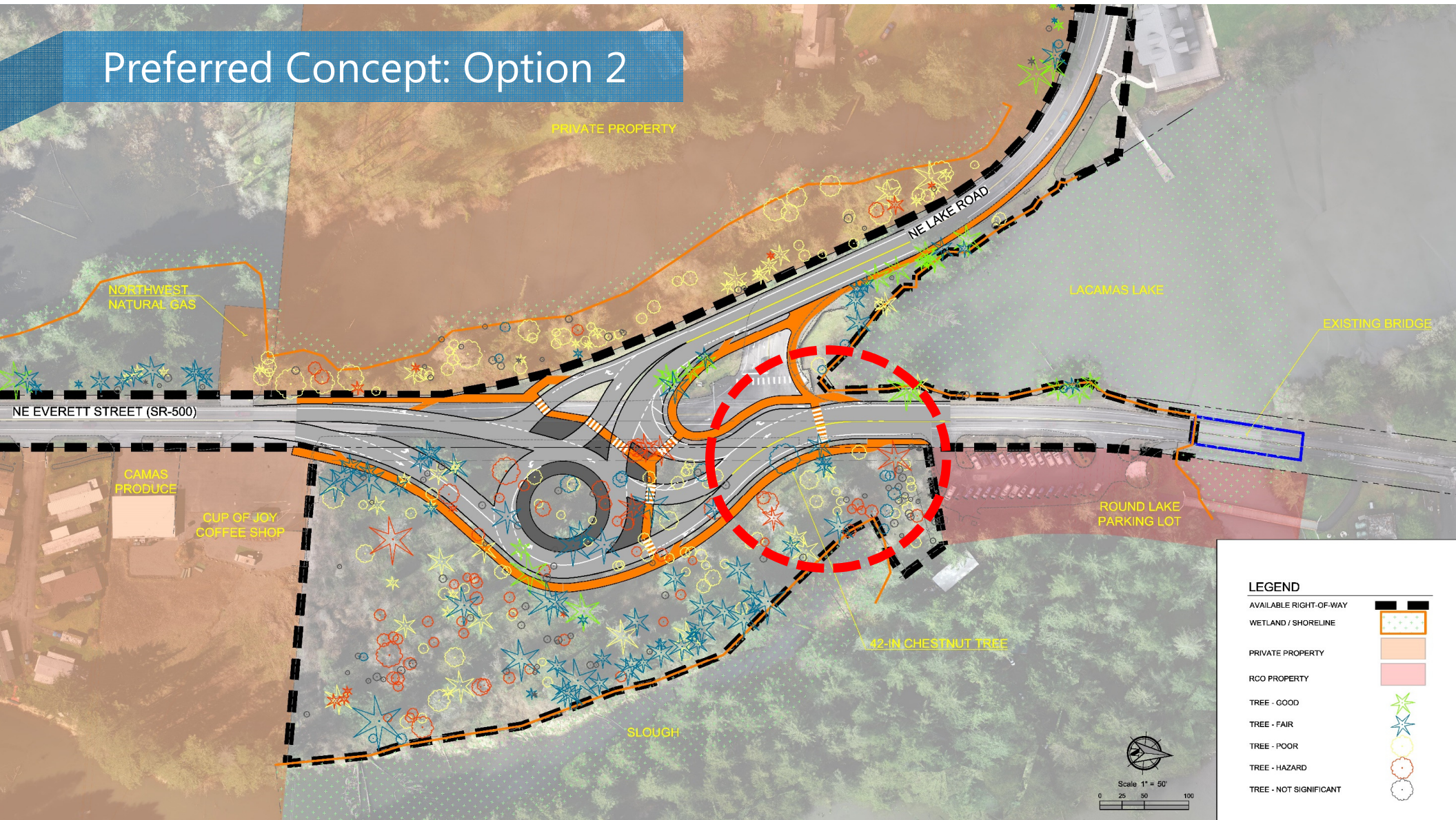


Preferred Alternative Recommendation

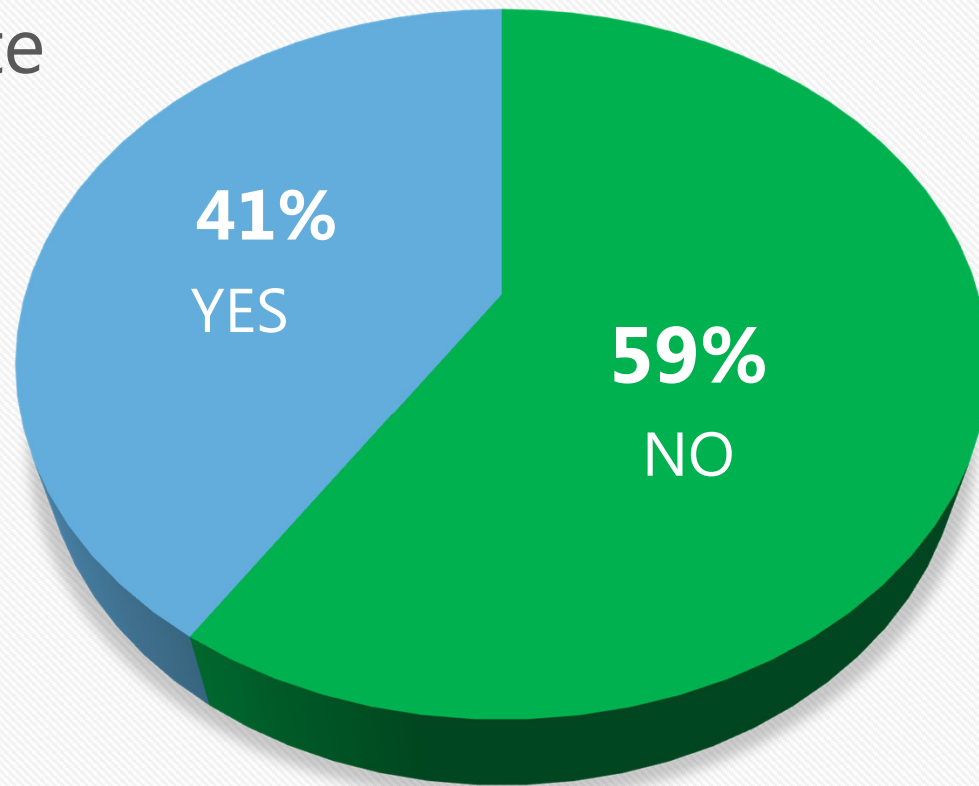
Most people preferred Option 1

- ✓ Larger landscape area within median



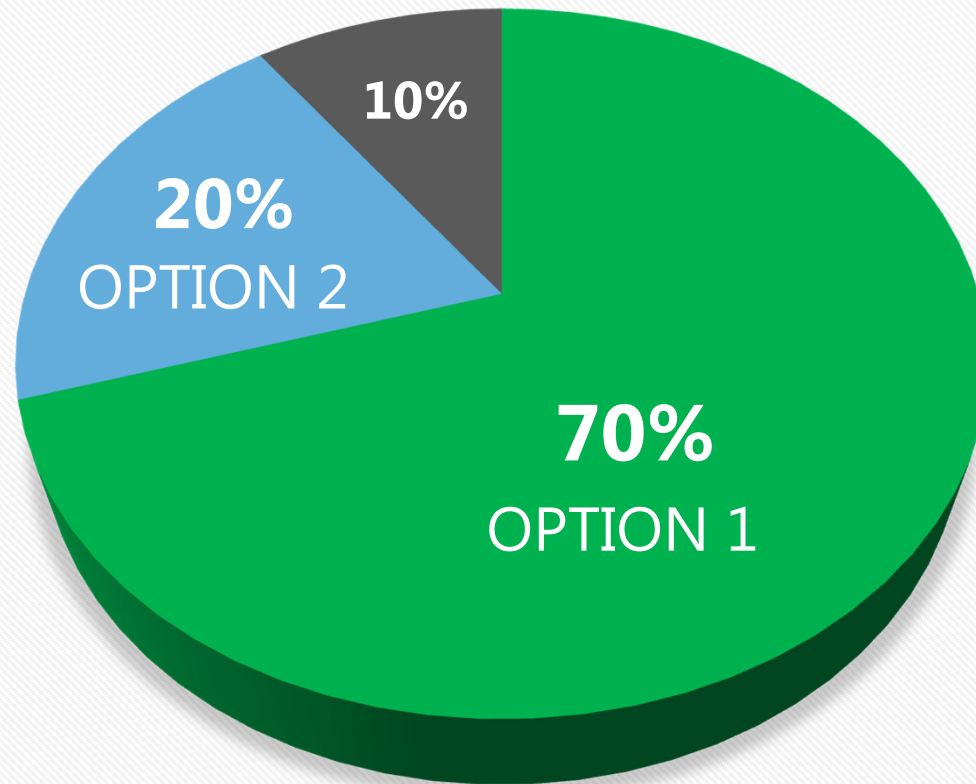
