Here is our input for the requests that were made:

Camas Antique - They asked for a "10 or 20 minute loading zone." We believe that a "loading zone" is not controlled by a time, but the term "actively loading or unloading." So, we don't support the addition of a set time to a loading zone. We ask that this one be turned down, unless it is just the standard "loading zone" which we're ok with.

Columbian Litho – They want a "30 minute" zone. We don't support this. The reason is when you have a 30 minute zone, for enforcement of that space, you need to mark it, then cruise around for 30 minutes, then come back and check on it. It keeps the Parking Enforcement Officer locked into the area for around 45 minutes total, just to monitor that space. We do support any number of 10 minutes spots, they are easy to enforce as you only need to wait around 10 minutes, then go back. Most of downtown is on a two hour check system so Tami goes through and marks, then waits two hours after the last car, then starts the loop over writing tickets. In that period, she has an easy time watching and checking the 10 minute spots. The longer spots are not as efficient for us. So the queston is - can Columbia Litho live with 10 minute spots?

The Happy Family change is ok with us.
