Details: The Six-Year Transportation Program is to be updated by municipal agencies annually per

Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 35.77.010. Projects from the Capital Facilities Plan,

Transportation Impact Fee Study Update and the North Dwyer Creek Master Plan are included in this plan as well as safety and maintenance and preservation items. Projects are dropped from the list annually once the construction phase has started and is fully funded. Staff has revised the attached list and map to reflect comments made by Council at the May 16, 2016 Council Workshop and via email. The SR-500 Lake Road Corridor Feasibility Study has been moved up the priority list to precede the Lake Road and Everett Roundabout Project. A bicycle and pedestrian improvements project has been added as Priority 28 for Brady Road from McIntosh Road to the west city limits. The attached appendices identify the coding on the list. There has been no public testimony received to date. Notice of this public hearing was posted on the Camas website, at the Post Office, City Hall,

Camas Library and in the Camas-Washougal Post-Record.
